Verti4You is a 36-month strategic partnership between HEIs, R&D institutions and NGOs working with fewer opportunities (FO) and NEET youth from Romania, Bulgaria, Italy and Greece.

Verti4You is promoting youth social entrepreneurship using vertical farming as a mean to produce ecofriendly and healthy food in rural, peri-urban, and urban areas. The final goal is social inclusion of people with reduced opportunities, by also supporting the transfer of the green skills of youth workers by educating them to produce microgreens with innovative vertical farming systems.

A project that aims to help the youth from 4 countries to start a business in vertical farming, by giving them 2 training materials, one training dedicated to the youth workers and 4 youth exchanges, with selected NEET & FO youth, in the 4 countries of the consortium, to work with the demonstrative vertical modules.



PROJECT OBJECTIVES

The project aims to strengthen key competences and basic skills in the field of modern horticulture - vertical systems, to empower young peoples with fewer opportunities and youth workers, to contribute to their own life and to their communities.

Verti4You intents to:

- develop cross-sectoral cooperation between HEI, R&D and NGOs for youth involvement enhancement,
- enhance innovation and technology transfer from academia to private sector, mainly to social enterprises and develop competences and abilities of youth workers (YW) and young people,
- 3. socially engage and include youth in education and training on STEM subjects (technology, automation, software) and enhance youth entrepreneurial innovative initiatives,
- 4 enhance NEET/FO youths' digital and technological awareness and practical skills by working with digital and latest technological developments in automation and software.

ACTIVITIES

2 digital training packs on Vertical Farming and Social entrepreneurship;

Design and implementation of 1 Youth Workers & Trainers Mentoring Event (8 youth workers and 8 trainers);

Design and implementation of **4 blended learning**, **teaching**, **and training mobilities** for building vertical modules and producing vegetables with those modules, involving at least **50 different young participants**;

Organization of 4 multiplier events, to reach a minimum of **320 people outside partners organizations.**
